Rubric and Expectations

(Home & School project)

Week 1/2 (April 8-13))

- **(3 pts) Subject**- choose 3 of 4 subjects to present and demonstrate to peer mentors (history, geography, botany, zoology)
- **(15 pts due Friday) (HOME) Topics for each chosen subject**- what is your topic/ main focus for each
 - (example: **botany**- flowers and their adaptations in Europe, **history**- timeline of 5 major events from World War II Germany (Europe), **geography**- making a 3D map (topographical) of the rivers/ mountains of S. America, **botany/ geography/ zoology**- a map of climatic zones and plants/ animals existing within the climatic zones, **zoology**- 3 animals with this continent and their importance within the habitat and the food chain/ web (think about the wolves)
 - **A total of 3 lessons**
- **(5 pts- due Friday) Schedule**- what day and times will you be presenting (10-20 minute lessons)

Once topics chosen:

- (5 pts) Research
- (5 pts) Bibliography at least 2 resources
- (2 pts) Proposal to demonstrate for lesson 1
 - (*power point, story- telling, puppet show, coloring project, Mobile, Virtual tour, Travel Brochure, Play, Creative Writing- song, poetry, game, etc.*)
- (2 pts) Peer mentor prompt questions or assignment for following week

Week 3 (April 23-27)

- (15 pts) Give Lesson 1 to peer mentors
- (5 pts) Research
- (5 pts) Bibliography- 2 new resources
- (2 pts) Proposal to demonstrate lesson 2
 - (*power point, story- telling, puppet show, coloring project, Mobile, Virtual tour, Travel Brochure, Play, Creative Writing- song, poetry, game, etc.*)
- (2 pts) Peer mentor prompt questions or assignment for following week

Week 4 (April 30-May 4)
