Projected Field Trips 2016 – 2017 School Year

Tuesday, Sept. 20th Duck Park & Lee's Marketplace (level 4,5,6)

All day TRANSPORTATION: Walk COST: free

Purpose: To study hands on science about aquifers/ springs, PH balance, microorganisms in the morning, and in the afternoon visiting Lee's Marketplace to learn about grocery stores (parts/purpose) as well as learn about nutrition and balancing a budget for groceries.

Tuesday, October 4 This is the Place (UE level 4's)

All day TRANSPORTATION: Bus COST: \$4

Purpose: To learn about the history of Utah. Participate in activities related to pioneers, Native Americans, train ride and reenactments of the time of the first Utah Pioneers.

Wednesday, Oct. 12th Lakeshore Learning Field Trip – Antelope Island (level 4)

All day TRANSPORTATION: private drivers COST: free

Purpose: The trips combine informal environmental education strategies while incorporating science, technology, engineering, art and math (STEAM) to reinforce the Utah Common Core State Science Standards.

Friday, Oct. 28th Wolf Creek Disc Golf and family picnic (level 4,5,6)

All day TRANSPORTATION: private drivers COST: free

Purpose: To expose and educate the youth about an exciting outdoor sport, disc golf, that is always outside and in nature. Expose them to exercise in a creative and outdoor fun environment. PE field trip. Also requires them to do math in an abstract way of keeping score.

Thursday, Nov. 10th Weber High School Play – Mary Poppins (level 4,5,6)

9:30-1:00 AM TRANSPORTATION: private drivers COST: \$2

Purpose: To expose students to the drama and theatrical part of art. Introduce them to story writing and acting in theater.

Wednesday, Jan. 11th America First Credit Union (level 4,5)

9:30-11:00 AM TRANSPORTATION: walk COST: free

Purpose: To learn about the purpose of banks and credit unions, see the parts of a credit union, to gain a better understanding of money and the path money travels. To learn the purpose of checks, loans and why budgeting and balancing money is important.

Wednesday, Jan.25 JA Bizztown (UE level 5)

All day TRANSPORTATION: private drivers COST: \$7

Purpose: This is a level field trip, related to economics. Having a greater understanding of jobs, responsibilities in society and how businesses work within the economy to keep society afloat.

Wednesday, Feb. 1st The Leonardo (level 4,5,6)

All day TRANSPORTATION: private drivers COST: \$2.50

Purpose: Participating in workshops that integrate principles of science, technology, engineering, math and the arts. Explore the different exhibits to gain a better understanding of the diversity in art, as well as learn the etiquette of being in a museum.

Wednesday, March 29 Clark Planetarium (UE level 6)

All day TRANSPORTATION: frontrunner COST: \$4 (frontrunner)

Purpose: To participate in activities and be guided by a specialist in the areas of 6th grade state science standards: moon phases, constellations, solar system, and seasons. The exhibits provide a better understanding of scale and perspective on the solar system- with corresponding hands on activities.

Purpose: Hands on fossil presentation covering core standards for science and much more! The discussion includes a discussion of the fossilization process and hands on examples of the different types of fossils.
