Dance Guidelines

All students and guests are required to be familiar with the policies, guidelines, and rules for dances and agree to abide by those expectations.

Only Maria Montessori Academy Jr. High students in good standing may attend and invite a non-MMA guest. All Maria Montessori Academy students who wish to invite ONE non-MMA student to the dance are required to pre-register that individual. No one who does not attend Maria Montessori Academy will be sold a ticket at the door.

The dance policy requires that individuals must remain in the building during the activity and will not be readmitted once they have left. Also, school policy prohibits the possession, use, or attendance while under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or other controlled substance, including tobacco. All students and guests are expected to enjoy the social activity without attempting to disrupt or otherwise intimidate other attendees.

Any individuals (Maria Montessori students or their guests) who leave the dance early will not be permitted to return for any reason.

All guests must also leave when the Maria Montessori Academy student who brought them to the dance leaves. This includes Maria Montessori Academy students as a guest of MMA.

No vulgar or suggestive dancing will be permitted. This would include most types of “grinding” and “front to back” dancing. The allowable types of dancing will be at the sole discretion of the chaperones.

Additional dress requirements other than those in the student handbook may be established by the sponsor of the dance.
