Some of the ways I have seen these projects presented it through a puppet show, a diorama, scrapbooks, dressing up, sharing food, dance and/or music or a poster. Most of the work should be completed by your student, they may need some help finding resources, having things read to them, etc. Some may need help with navigating the computer and or printer. Trish and I have been giving them ideas and things to work on in class, remind them to bring these home so you can add them to the presentation. We have encouraged this, however sometimes they forget, or it gets lost in the back pack.

Level 1's include something about an animal(s).

Level 2's include something about plants, (remember many of the foods eaten contain plants).

Level 3's include something about the climate, and land forms.

Your student may choose to do their entire report on one of these subjects or include many ideas and information. Some of these ideas may include, money, people, landmarks, food, history, famous people or events, tourist attractions, flowers, holidays, etc.

Some of the things that should be included in the report

Student's name

Name of continent North America

Name of Country

Flag

Map of Country and/or map of where country is found in North America.
