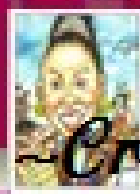

Rosa Parks

Late one evening, Rosa Parks was leaving her job as a seamstress and was very tired. She boarded a crowded bus, and sat down ready for a long ride home. Soon at another stop, a white man got on the bus and demanded Mrs. Parks give him her seat. During this time, blacks were required by law to stand up on the bus if there were no seats for white people. Rosa decided to nicely refuse to give up her seat and was arrested. Her arrest led to a national bus boycott. A boycott is when everyone decides to not do something. Eventually everyone was able to sit where they wanted on buses. Her bravery and dedication led to an extraordinary civil rights advancement.
