(Please note that these supplies are by donation only. If you cannot provide these supplies for our classroom please let me know so the school can provide them. Please email Ms. Amy if you have questions.)

- *Flash drive 6 GB Recommended (This will be used for their projects and portfolios.)
- *Lunch Box labeled with student's name in permanent marker
- *Plastic placemat for lunch label on the back with your child's name
- *Refillable water bottle labeled with student's name in permanent marker
- *Clipboard (returning students if you already have a clipboard bring it back to school with you. New students please bring a clipboard to class. We use them every day.)
- *Slippers (indoor shoes) can be Croc-like no flip-flops. Plain slippers without cartoon characters or designs. All students will HAVE to wear slippers, they cannot just wear socks around the school. This is part of our dress code.

1 inch white three ring binder (This will be used as their portfolio, if at all possible please send your child with a <u>white 1 inch three ring binder</u> – last year the binders were all shapes and sizes. They didn't fit on the shelf and always looked messy. I will label these.)
