The expectation for full points is that the work be at the student's individual work level and that the student does the work. Families can help the student, but the work should reflect the student's level of knowledge and age/ability level.

This project can be presented in any way the student would like. Be creative with your mode of presentation. The written report needs to include EVERYTHING on the rubric. The presentation needs to include as much as possible. Some ideas for their presentation: powerpoint, t-shirt, poster, poem, play, puppet show. Your only limitation is your imagination. ☺

Scoring Rubric: based upon individual expectations:

Heading of Project / Project ____/30 points

- Name of your country and Continent (Nice and big in the center - make it attention getting) - 10 pts
- Your name clearly and neatly - 10 pts
- Have a flag from your country. -10 pts

Tourism ____/30 points

- Language- what is the language spoke, provide examples and their meaning List at least 5 words and their translation into the native language. -10 pts
- Currency / Exchange Rate - What is their money called?
How much of their money equals \$1 of ours?
OPTIONAL - list other currency exchange rates. -10 pts
- Tell us about 2 or more major cities that people would choose to visit in your country. What makes those cities so interesting? Explain landmarks, events, cultural significance or anything else those cities might have to offer tourists and visitors. -10 pts

People ____/40 points

- Population (How many people live in your country?) -10 pts
- Dress / Clothing (What are traditional or cultural clothing styles of the people?) INCLUDE A PICTURE OF TRADITIONAL CLOTHING -10 pts
- Customs (Tell us about some traditions of the people - what do they celebrate?) - OR - Holidays (Choose at least two to tell us about) -10 pts
- Food (Are there certain foods that are common or considered a delicacy - something the country is known for?) -10 pts

Geography ____/40 points

- Describe the climate of your country and have a map (location of your country) -10 pts
- Physical features on a map (mountains, rivers, canyons...features of your country) -10 pts
- What is the major biome in your country? -10 pts
 - What kinds of animals live in this biome? Are any of them endangered? -5 pts
 - What kinds of plants live in this biome? Are any used for exports? -5 pts

- Famous Person - Someone that is well known that either lived/lives in that country or is from that country originally. Why are they famous, what's so "great" about them?
- Current Event - Find an article of a current even that is happening in your country. Your article should be as current as possible. The article must be attached to your board. You will write a summary about your article, think who?, what?, where?, when?, why? And how? to help you write a complete summary of your current event.
- Animal - Information on an animal that is either native to your country or one your country is well known for. Include the animals habitat, what it eats, what eats it, life expectancy, does it hibernate, where is it located on the food web, is it a house pet.
- Historical Event - An important event that helped shape your country's history, possibly one that they celebrate or honor.
- Family life - Information on daily life in the country you have chosen, housing, jobs etc.
- School - what is the school day like? Homework? Classroom? Describe what it would be like to be a student in your country.
- Natural Events - Major natural disasters that frequently affect your country (ie: earthquakes, tornadoes and list the latest natural disaster etc).
- Imports/Exports (What does your country grow or make that they sell to other places?) What are some things it imports? (needs to bring in to their country)
- Main Industry (What is your country known for, what brings in the most money to your country?)
- Natural Resources (What natural resources can be found in your country)
- Sports - Which sport is your country known for? What is your countries populations favorite sport?
- Movies - Tell us about a movie which was made about the country.
