A Message from the Director:

February is filled with visions of hearts, chocolates and cupids. For me, February reminds me of the importance of learning and demonstrating compassion. It has been said in a variety of ways that families are a child's first and most influential teacher. We, at MMA believe that and rely heavily on our partnership with you to educate your child. The following strategies can aid in our partnership to build compassion in our students:

- Believe that your children are capable of being kind.
- Model positive action- What you do and say is critical; let your child catch you in the act of being kind.
- Treat children with respect.
- Coach your child to pay attention to facial expression- This is the first step in learning how to understand others perspectives.
- Don't let rudeness pass.
- Acknowledge kindness. Be sure to show your child that you notice when someone does something kind.
- Be sensitive to the messages you child picks up from the media.
- Explain that calling someone names or excluding him from play can be just as hurtful as hitting.
- Show children how to help someone in need.
- Be patient with you little ones, because kindness and compassion are learned and life presents challenging situations.

Being a loving parent and a great role model will go a long way to raising a compassionate human being. Thankfully, there are many things we can do to encourage children to be kinder, gentler people.

There will be a shuttle available at "Eden Park & Ride" for \$2 per person.


Registration for both ski nights will be during PTC Feb. 9th-11th from 1pm-6pm. Other registration dates TBA.
