## CTE Introduction Overview

CTE Intro is a required course for 7<sup>th</sup> grade students. Through CTE Intro, students participate in activity-centered lessons to utilize technology, develop beginning skills, and explore careers by expanding awareness. CTE Intro provides information regarding future classes and training related to each student's career field of interest. (Formerly TLC)

## Rotations & Content Areas



Students will explore career options in the areas of communication, manufacturing and construction, power and energy, transportation and agriculture.



This course provides students the opportunity to learn essential life skills. It allows them to develop skills in food and nutrition, childcare and safety, clothing construction and style, consumerism, family relationships, personal responsibility, and job-related tasks.



Students will explore essential employee characteristics and current technology and software applications used in business. A simulation will be conducted using the technology and skills introduced in the course.



Career Development Activities include 19 days of lesson plans designed to help students discover specific information about himself or herself through self-knowledge, education and occupation exploration, and career planning.

## Rotation Schedule

- Each CTE Intro rotation will be approximately 12 weeks long.
- CTE Intro students will change instructors during the year at the times listed to the left.
- Each rotation will also include several Career Development lessons taught by the teachers and the counselors.

# Academic & Citizenship Grades

Academic grades will be determined by class participation and completion of individual and group assignments. Academic grades are based on the school wide grading scale.

CTE Introduction is a very hands-on, project based class. Participation and attendance is very important. If work is missed due to absences please consult with your teacher to find out how to make up the missed work.
