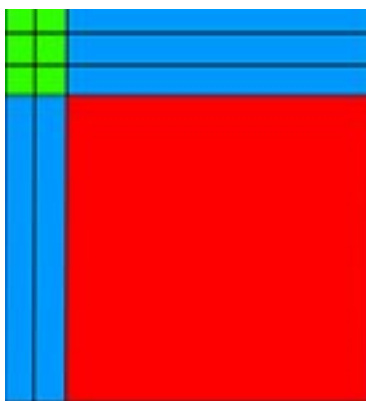


CTE Introduction Study Guide Cycle I "Structure" Oct 6-10
