There are six personality types in Holland's model and most people will fit into a few of the categories:

- Realistic: practical, physical, concrete, hands-on, machine, and tool-oriented
- <u>Investigative</u>: analytical, intellectual, scientific, explorative, thinker
- Artistic: creative, original, independent, chaotic, inventive, media, graphics, and text
- <u>Social</u>: cooperative, supporting, helping, healing/nurturing, teaching
- Enterprising: competitive environments, leadership, persuading, status
- Conventional: detail-oriented, organizing, clerical
