
Keyboarding & Digital Literacy Study guide Dec 1-5 Ut ah Compose

Checklist

As a class watch the YouTube clip about job shadowing (link on MMAjr)
Open browser (Firefox, Internet Explorer, Chrome) http://utahcompose.com
Log in with you SIS number using 000 in front of your student number (Ms Emily has this information if you need it, you may change your pass code if you like)
Go to keyboarding or digital literacy (which ever you currently have)
Press the practice tab and find 'Job Shadow Experience'

When you begin your writing you are welcome to copy and paste from your reflection form. You may also copy and paste from a word processing program. If you want to finish working on it later click "save & quite." Otherwise, you can submit your work using the "submit" button.

If you were unable to secure job shadow situation talk to Ms. Emily today for your assigned topic to research and present this week. (7th graders present in CTE, 8th graders do not have to present unless they want to arrange to present to the CTE students during 2nd or 6th period) All students are required to complete the Utah Compose essay and will be given time to do so this week during their respective keyboarding and digital literacy classes.
