Essential question: What careers are related to the production, processing, distribution & consumption of agricultural products?

Overview: Agriculture is a science-based, high-tech field that offers a variety of career possibilities. In the United States, the food and agriculture sector is almost entirely under private ownership & is composed of 2.2 million farms, 900,000 restaurants, & more than 400,000 registered food manufacturing, processing, and storage facilities. The sector supports a workforces of nearly 22 million.
