Fixed & Growth Mindset sort. In groups of 3 or 4 sort into two categories: fixed & growth. Extension: pair the fixed with the opposite growth set match.

Intelligence is the ability to learn quickly and easily and you either got it or not. It's fixed.

Look smart at all costs.

Effort is bad. If you have to work hard you are not smart.

If you don't get it at first you either wilt or run.

If something is hard you may decide to spend less time on it or do things to avoid it.

Intelligence can be developed over time

Learn at all costs

Effort is good

Working hard makes you smarter

Focus is on learning.

If you don't do well on something you want, your determination increases and you want to spend more time working toward mastery.
