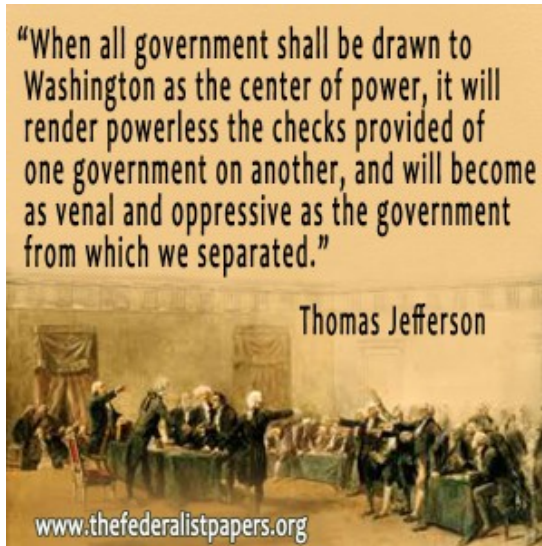


**U.S. History/Utah Studies Study Guide
Structures****Overview**

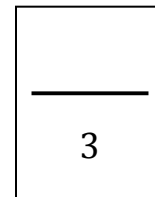
