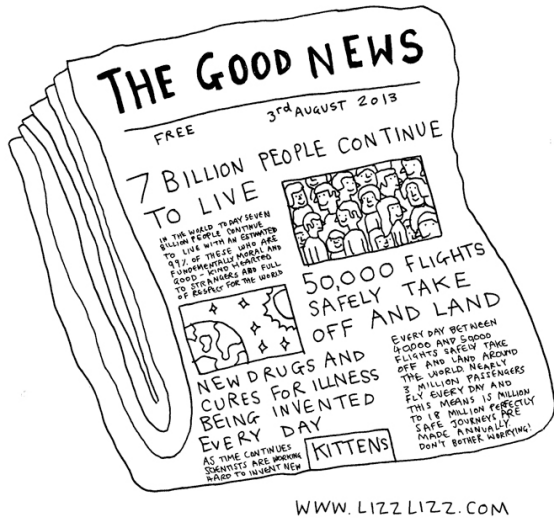


Utah Studies Study Guide Interdependence

Overview

Weeks 7-9 (May 2 - 18) Complete the following:

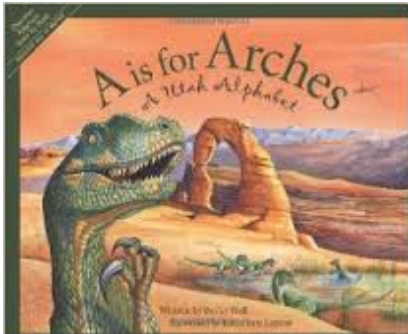
_____ 1. Current Event Summary—Pick one of the following categories:
