READING LITERATURE STANDARD 7

WHAT IS THE STANDARD: "Compare and contrast a written story, drama, or poem to its audio, filmed, staged or multimedia version, analyzing the effects of techniques unique to each medium."
WHAT IT MEANS: Every different type of artistic genre, or artistic creation, is made up of many different effects and techniques to create each genre. Compare and contrast multiple versions of the same/similar works, discussing those effects and techniques.

LEVEL 2: Retrieve the Nightmare before Christmas movie poster from the Unit Binder. Find the following things: movie title, producer, movie release date (approximately). How many other things did the author include? List as many as possible, with a minimum of 5.

LEVEL 3: Rewrite your list of at least 8 things (3 from my example, 5 of your own) from the movie poster on another section in your ISN. Why would the artist put forth the effort of including those? Explain why you think he/she includes each one; write a whole sentence for each different effect (thing on the poster.)

LEVEL 4: Just like the movie poster artist, Neil Gaiman made choices when writing this book. The artwork on the pages has a certain style to it. How would you describe it? Think back to L2 from last week. We discussed another technique that added to the reader's experience. What other effects or techniques do you see that he used in the book? List at least 3 more.
