

Physical Education- beginning team sports/intermediate activities **Mr. Swain**

Course Description: Students will develop an understanding of rules and regulations for different activities that require physical activity. Skills and game play will be included to enhance sports participation and teamwork. Students will be required to participate in both individual and teamwork activities. When groups are made for teamwork activities accommodations will be made based upon skill level, grade level, and safety considerations.

Course Expectations: Students will respect each other and the equipment provided by the school. All equipment must only be used in the appropriate manner. Students may bring shorts and a T-shirt to change in and out of for class. If students decide to bring clothing to change into, shorts must be at least finger tip in length (or as outlined in the school rules), and shirts must at least cover the shoulder. No cut offs or muscle T-shirts allowed. Written assignments will be given. Students will need pencil and paper to complete the tests and or assignments.

Textbooks and Materials:

No text books are given, but students do need the following:

- 1. writing utensils (pen that has blue or black ink, and or pencil)
- 2. lined paper or notebook
- 3. crayons, colored pencils, and or markers

Grading Plan:

Students will not be graded on dress. Students will be graded on knowledge of the rules and regulations of each particular game or activity. Assessments will be given to the students periodically to test their knowledge. Assessment may include but are not limited to; verbal, written, physical (i.e. performing the skill). A total of four points can be earned each class period. One point will be given for each of the following:

- -Attendance
- -Following Instructions
- -Performing the skills or activity
- -Showing respect for teacher, fellow classmates and the equipment
