Topic: My Place in the World

How to Submit: Submit each text genre separately via Google Classroom by Nov. 11th. Ms. Lisa will print all the text genres, and you will compile the text with the visual into a final book in class on Nov. 12-13.

Feedback: Submit genres early to get feedback for improvement.

Requirements	1	2	3	4	5
1. 5-6 different genres; 1 genre repeated; 6-7 TOTAL genres					
2. One genre is visual					
3. One genre is a personal narrative that is 1 ½ - 2 pages in length AND one other genre is 1-2 pages in length					
4. "Bookending" is used (same genre used for first and last genre)					
5. Transition quote between each genre					
6. Font style is appropriate for each genre					
7. Font size for each genre is 11-12					
8. Creative title page relating to topic					
9. Ideas: Each genre tells a different part of your place in the world. All genres work together to tell one complete idea. The topic (my place in the world) is thoroughly and honestly explored over the course of the paper. The idea within each genre is clear and understandable.					
10. Organization: The order of the genres makes sense. Ideas flow from one genre to the next. Only one genre per page. Transition quotes are used between each genre. Transition quotes help to link ideas together. Genres that are multi-paragraph use paragraphs correctly and effectively.					
11. Voice: Use correct person (first person or third person) for each genre. Personal narrative especially sounds like you. All genres are sincere and engaging. It is obvious reading the whole paper that you are enthusiastic and committed to what you are writing about. Is entertaining.					
12. Word Choice: Uses grade-level vocabulary (or higher). Correctly uses new vocabulary words learned from <i>TKAM</i> . Repeated words are for effect, but not redundant. Wide range and variety in vocabulary. Correct use of figurative language (alliteration, onomatopoeia, simile, metaphor, personification, and/or hyperbole).					
13. Sentence Fluency: Uses appropriate sentence style for each genre. Uses a variety of sentence types and lengths. In Personal Narrative, no fragments or run-ons. Has varied and unique sentence beginnings. Use of comma/conjunction and semi-colon to join sentences.					
14. Conventions: Spelling, variety of punctuation (.,!;-), capitalization, and grammar are correct and used effectively. Cites source for each quote used. Tries to use more challenging punctuation and grammar. Use of parallel structure. Tries to spell more difficult words.					

Genres: newspaper article, scrapbook page, cartoon, graphic novel, personal narrative, recipe, resume, billboard, poem, tombstone, help wanted ad, flyer, play or movie script, song lyrics, wordle, list, persuasive or informative essay, haiku, map, mind-map, crossword puzzle, journal/diary entry, narrative
