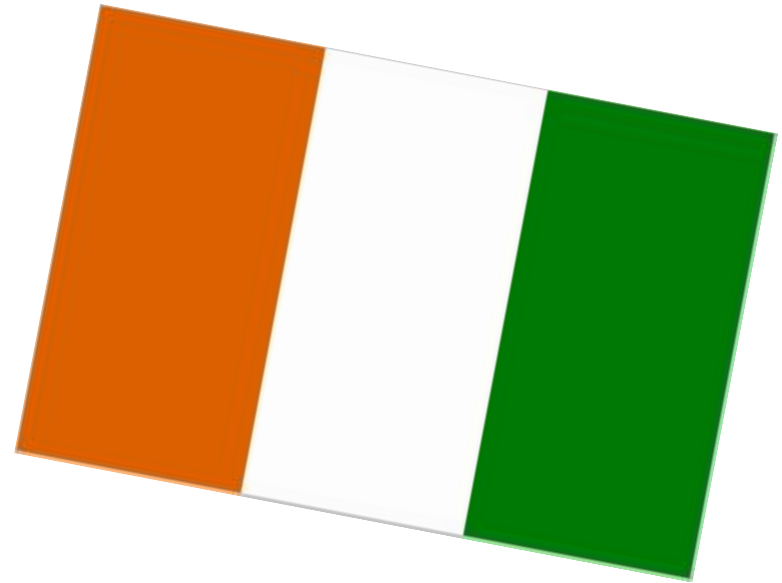

Life in Cote d'Ivoire

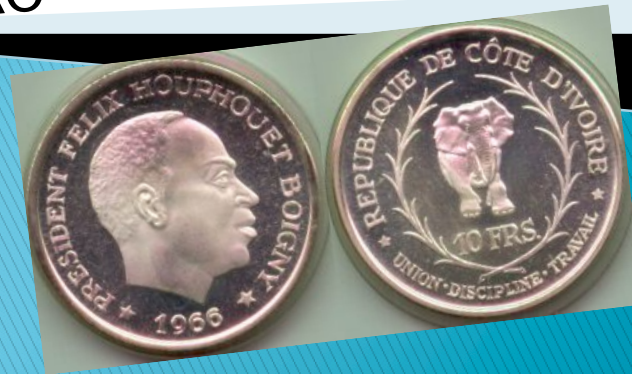
Food: rice, cassava, and yams.

Education

Students must pay tuition for secondary school.
