
### WHO WERE THEY?

gatherers






### **HOW DID THEY GET OVER TO THE AMERICAS?**

Game was plentiful in the Great Plains region


Once game was running low they moved

They did have a ton of room to move!












# PALEO-INDIAN FOOD



### **SHELTER FOR PALEO-INDIANS**

Paleo Indians were *nomadic*meaning they moved from
place to place killing animals
