_____ Daily Geography

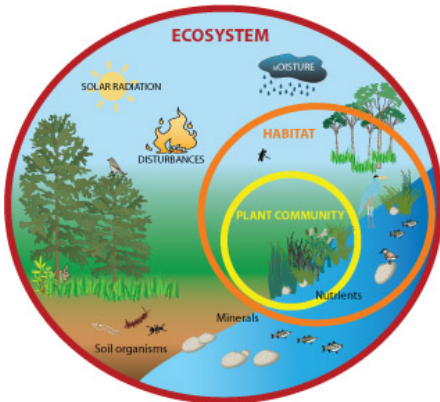
Students answer 8 questions that they write in their journal.
