Education

- * Many Germans believe that free time or extra curricular with minimal adult supervision allows kids to develop important values like respect and empathy






Berlin Wall

- * August 13, 1961 GDR (German Democratic Republic "East Germany") began to build a barbed/cement wall separating East and West Germany
- ♦ Purpose: prevent western "fascist" to enter east Berlin to undermine the socialist state
- ♦ Took about two weeks to make
- ♦ You would get shot if you climbed the wall from West to
 East
