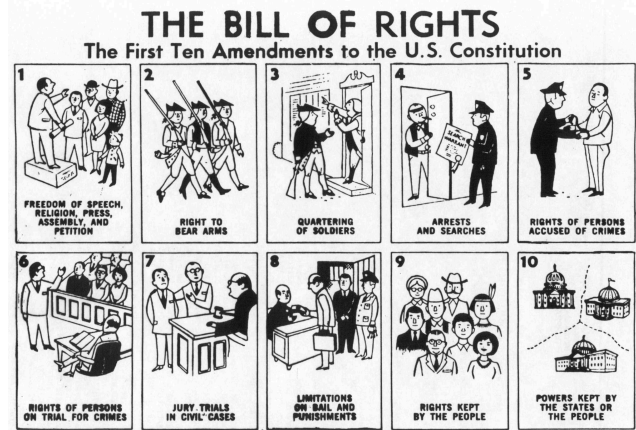
Essential Questions:

_____ Role of Explorers

Students will create a report about one of the following group or individual explorers: Lewis and Clark, Pike, Fremont, Mountain Men, Mormon Pioneers, California 49ers, Asian and Irish immigrants, etc.

Role of Explorers Proficiency Scale:

95: Who is this group/individual? Where did they travel from and where did they travel? What path or trail did they take? What states did they travel to or pass through? Who did they travel with? What was their motive to expand west? What were they looking for? Did they find anything along the way? What materials/animals/weapons/etc. did they bring with them?
