escription of Activity: If you are a part of the advanced hiking club, you can expect an increase in speed in comparison to the eginning group. Our group likes to hike for the full 2 hours, so we are not sauntering along. Also, hikers can expect an increase in the ate of elevation increase. We want to build hikers to be able to enjoy hikes that get the heart pumping. We will be learning about blobal Positioning Systems and will implement them to locate hidden caches up on the Bonneville Shoreline. At each hike we will take look at wind speed, names of trails, directions, safety on the trail, and use the starting elevation and our highest elevation to figure ow far we have climbed.
