# **Vocabulary Word Exercises**

Please select four vocabulary words from the available list and undertake one of the following options for each of the words. Staple your four words/pages together and submit them (turn them in) on or before the due date outlined in your checklist.

## **Anatomy of a Vocabulary Word:**

Based on a vocabulary word's meaning, create a character that represents the word, and then label the features of the character. To earn full points:

- The word must be used correctly in one of the labels.
- There needs to be five or more labels applied to the character.
- The labels must contain interesting words and thoughtful descriptions.
- No spelling or punctuation errors.
- The definition and part of speech must be included.

### **Super Hero Vocabulary Word:**

Based on a vocabulary word's meaning, create a superhero or super-villain inspired by the word. Then create that super-character's nemesis. To earn full points:

- The superhero's description must be two or three sentences.
- The super-villain's description must be two or three sentences.
- The personification must somehow embody the word that inspired supercharacter, and his nemesis should embody the word's antonym.
- No spelling or punctuation errors.
- The definition and part of speech must be included.

### Word Art Vocabulary Activity:

Based on a vocabulary word's meaning, create a visual display where the word's letters represent ideas and connections they've made. To earn full points:

- The word art must contain four obvious connections to the word's meaning.
- The writer must include an explanation of each of the connections below the word art.
- The visual elements must be thoughtful and creative.
- No spelling or punctuation errors.
- The definition and part of speech must be included.

#### **Fake Horror Movie Poster:**

Based on a vocabulary word's meaning, create a poster for an imaginary horror movie whose title either contains the word or whose "tag line" contains the word. To earn full points:

- The word must be used correctly in the title or the tag line.
- The tag line must be catchy and creative, like a real movie's tag line.
- The illustration must show knowledge of the word.
- No spelling or punctuation errors.
- The definition and part of speech must be included.

## **Phone App Vocabulary Word:**

Based on a vocabulary word's meaning, create a phone application that is either called the word or whose description contains the word. To earn full points:

- App description must be four or more sentences and show knowledge of word.
- App must have a logo that shows understanding of the word.
- A review of the app must be included.
- No spelling or punctuation errors.
- The definition and part of speech must be included.
