

Level 5 Cultural Study Guide – Egypt

A 3 week Unit Plan – November 30-December 18

All work due at the end of each week.

Reading Comprehension

- In lieu of Steck Vaughn and NPR during morning work cycle, complete “The Tomb of Tutankhamen” and “Ancient Egypt” as well as the graphic organizers that accompany them.

Math

- In lieu of large operations during one morning’s work cycle, complete the Picture Math using the “Egyptian Number System” document.

Cultural Study Unit

- In pairs, you will complete one section from each of the following units:
- Issues, People and Places

Issues – November 30-December 4

Monday: Complete a map of Ancient Egypt labeling all major physical geographical features

Tuesday-Thursday: “Getting the Facts”

Choose 3 of the 4 following options to explore: Language Arts, Social Studies, Math or Science

Once the 3 options are complete and signed off, you may complete the Art Option

Friday: Present what you learned to the rest of the 5th grade students – 7 minute time limit

People – December 7-December 11

Monday-Wednesday: “Getting the Facts”

Choose 3 of the 4 following options to explore (you must include one that you excluded last week): Language Arts, Social Studies, Math or Science

Once the 3 options are complete and signed off, you may complete the Art Option

Friday: Present what you learned to the rest of the 5th grade students – 7 minute time limit

Places – December 15-18

Tuesday-Wednesday: “Getting the Facts”

Choose 2 of the 4 following options to explore (you must include one that you excluded last week): Language Arts, Social Studies, Math or Science

Once the 2 options are complete and signed off, you may complete the Art Option

Friday: Present what you learned to the rest of the 5th grade students – 7 minute time limit
