- Complete the attached resource log. If your search turns up few or no titles on your topic, consider switching to a related topic with more results, or to your alternative topic.
- Check out at least **3** resources (not encyclopedias) that will be excellent for your research. At this point, they should all be books, rather than electronic sources. Bring the books to school for next week's meeting.
