Last week, we learned about rounding. Rounding is when you make a number end in a zero. For example, 17 rounded to the nearest ten is 20, because 20 is the closest number to 17. But 15 is right in the middle of 10 and 20 so which would it be? Because 15 is in the middle, we round it up to 20. I think rounding is important because it can help simplify math.

Another thing we did last week was learn about early man. We learned about what they did to hunt animals. We also learned about how they made tools to chop trees for shelter. We also learned that during ice ages there were no plants for animals to eat. This means that we had a hard time surviving.

Last week, I also taught people how to crochet. Crocheting is like knitting but with a single hook. I think crocheting is fun because you can do it when you are bored. It's relaxing and helps calm your mind. I had fun teaching other students how to crochet.

These are a few of the things that we did this week. We also did many other things but these were some of the main things I saw happening.
